Two-Part Haiti Trip

When we started praying about going back to Haiti and where and when, we had no idea what God would open up for us. Now we know. We will be spending three weeks in Haiti this summer from July 3-23. We will be working in two different locations. The first part of the trip will be working on a community project with our church. We will be conducting a census and evaluating the assets of a community in Northern Haiti. The second part of our trip will be with the Hands and Feet project at their new children's home in Grand Goave. See the back for a detailed explanation of the trip and how you can help.





Part 1

Our home church, Woodford Community Christian Church, is starting to develop a Neighbors project through Northwest Haiti Christian Mission. This project entails partnering with a community in the region and helping them help themselves. This trip will include a census of the community to determine their assets and needs as well as possibly putting on a revival in the community. This will be from July 2-11.

Part 2

After a brief visit with family from July 11-15 we will meet up with another group organized by someone who went with us back in April after the earthquake. This trip will be with the Hands and Feet project. They have one children's home in Jacmel, Haiti and are starting another in Grand Goave, which is where we will be working for the second part of our trip in helping with the constructions and beginnings of this home. We will be there from July 16-23.
